## NWFCU Foundation's Food for Kids Drive Collects More Than 32K Food Items

(October 1, 2020)** –<u>The Northwest Federal Credit Union (NWFCU) Foundation</u>, the charitable arm of <u>Northwest Federal Credit Union</u>, recently concluded their Food for Kids Drive, collecting 32,000+ food items for local children in need. The drive was in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, which has increased the need for supplemental food for area school children. It ran from June 1<sup>st</sup> through the end of August and included a new partnership for the Foundation with Giant Food.

In addition to food donations, the Foundation received significant cash donations for this food drive, which will allow for future food deliveries as the pandemic continues this fall.
